

What's New in Engage 3.8?

Introduction

Engage 3.8 introduces feature improvements that enhance general usability for all users.

The purpose of this document is to provide a high-level overview of significant updates that are relevant to students and faculty. Detailed, step-by-step support documentation will be available to all users in Engage when the platform is updated.

Forum Inline Editing

With inline editing, users can easily start a new discussion or reply to forums. The reply box appears inline, allowing the user to quickly respond. If a more detailed reply is needed, for example, needing the editing toolbar or attachment box, clicking Advanced will display the full version.

Quiz: Clear my choice option

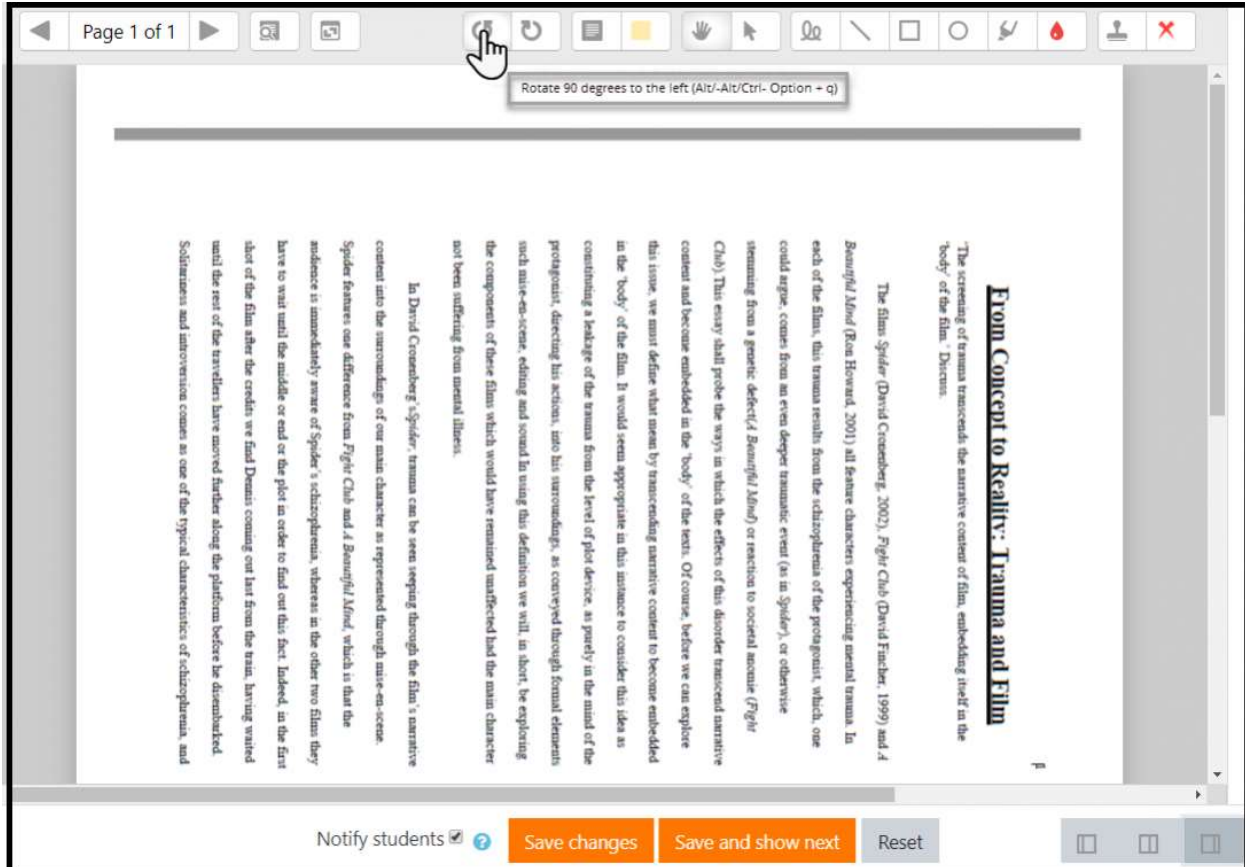
In a multiple-choice question, users have the capability to remove their choice using the clear my choice option.

Forum Grading Updates

Forums grade settings provide more granular options to grade forum posts. The revamped forum grading interface enables instructors to easily grade student contributions directly from their posts, quickly view discussions in context and easily collapse the grading panel to free up more screen space.

Instructors can benefit from accessing forum discussions with whole forum grading, using direct or advanced grading. The interface improvements offer less scrolling and easier navigation.
